

## Indicator 5: Migration Characteristics

**Introduction:** An area's migration patterns are often indicative of its labour force characteristics. Areas offering the greatest employment opportunities attract more people than they lose. Areas that offer fewer employment opportunities tend to lose more people than they attract.
